



General Education Policy for Students Transferring to UMM

1. If you are a transfer student matriculating at UMM with a completed Associate in Arts (AA) or Associate in Science (AS) degree from a regionally accredited institution you will have met the General Education Core except for:
 - ELA 112 Community and Place
 - ELA 2xx Humans and Nature

2. If you are a transfer student matriculating at UMM without a completed AA or AS but with at least 60 credits (in transfer or from UMM prior to matriculation), you will be allowed to use the options specified below to meet the indicated requirements of the General Education Core:

<i>General Education Core Requirement</i>		<i>You may:</i>
ELA 101 Recreation & Wellness	3 cr	Meet with a transferable course in Personal Wellness
ELA 112 Community and Place	3 cr	Meet with a transferable course in Sociology, Psychology, Anthropology, Economics, Business, Philosophy, Marine Biology or History
Social Sciences & the Environment	3 cr	Meet with a transferable course in Sociology, Psychology, Anthropology, Economics, Philosophy, Recreation, Social Science or Environmental Science
Historical Perspectives	6 cr	Meet with any two transferable courses in History - one must be non-Western

Note: As for all students, you may not apply a course towards two different sections of our General Education Core program.

Additionally, as a transfer student with 60 credits or more but no AA or AS, you must complete the other remaining components of the General Education Core either at UMM or in transfer:

ELA 2xx Humans and Nature	3 cr
Communication Skills	6 cr
Aesthetic Perspectives	4 cr
Literary Perspectives	3 cr
